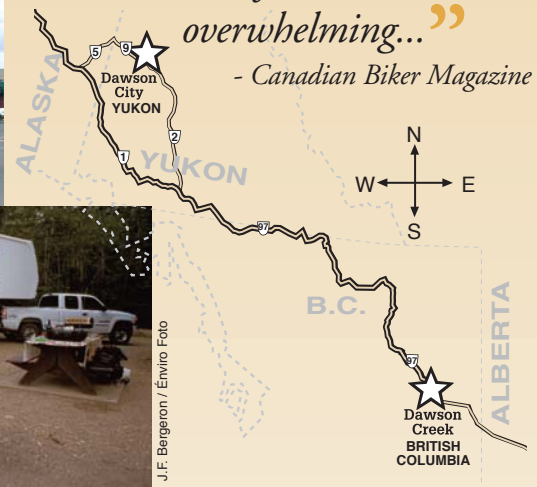
FROM MILE '0' ALASKA HIGHWAY TO THE LAND OF THE MIDNIGHT SUN

Spend some time in Dawson Creek. Visit the stone cairn that marks the actual beginning of the Alaska Highway and take a picture of yourself at the Mile Zero Post! Stop at the Northern Alberta Railways Park, where you'll find the historic Station Museum and Visitor Centre. The museum, housed in the original 1931 railway station, features an extensive collection of highway memorabilia, pioneer artifacts and wildlife displays. Also in the Park is the Art Gallery, located in a renovated grain elevator.

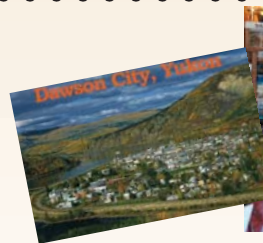

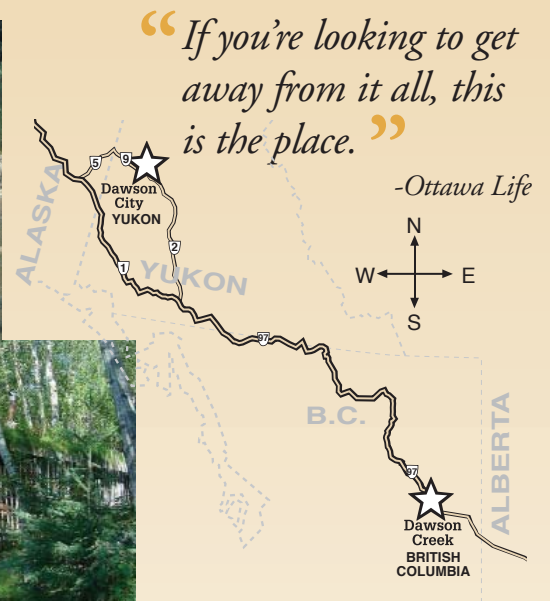
